For the better part of the past decade, Austin's Meat Purveyors have been the skunk tossed into the tent of stoic bluegrass revivalism. Always more Brothers Ramone than Brothers Osborne and more comfy in jack boots than cowboy boots, TMP have always been able to out-lament most of the current day crop of high lonesome pretenders. Top shelf musicianship, razor sharp songwriting and a total lack of concern for the confines of genre, make The Meat Purveyors one of the most entertaining and energetic outfits plying the dark corners of the roots underground.

Besides being the most predictably correct album title of all time, *Someday Soon Things Will Be Much Worse!*, reveals that, after four albums, TMP still got some tricks to lay on us all. Yes, just when you think you've got a bead

on their fifth gear punk/bluegrass hybrid, just when you got used to their fondness for reinventing arena rock staples from the likes of Ratt as Opry-worthy weepers, and just when you learned to make for the exit when the bar owner says there's no more beer for the band, TMP lets it rip—ELECTRIC. Never before has the demon electricity reared its ugly head on one of their records, but *Someday Soon...* plugs in for a few songs and adds another head to the TMP hydra.

Austin Music Hall of Fame inductee / guitar aggressor **Bill Anderson** has assumed the role of the backbone of the band. Not only does he have the uncanny gift for writing loss and lament-style tunes, he's also the stand-up guy that holds your hair back in the ally behind the bar after a long night of tequila shots. **Jo Walston** belts out the songs with her trademark 'I'll bust your jaw and spit down your neck' attitude while **Cherilyn DiMond** keeps the low-end on upright bass duty and adds air-tight harmonies and menacing stage banter. Giving the band their bluegrass street cred, **Pete Stiles** has got the speed AND the finesse to stand alongside any mandolin player we've ever heard.
